
# CARDBOARD CITY 2016



## CARDBOARD CITY GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPANTS



Registration is from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Saturday, September 17, 2016.

Parents or guardians must sign registration form for participants under the age of 18.

All pledge money is due at registration. Checks should be made payable to the Clinton County Homeless Shelter. Bring your sponsorship/Pledge List.

Registration desk is in the large tent on the south lawn of the Clinton County Courthouse.

There must be at least one sponsor for each ten participants.

- One chaperon for each group must be awake at all times.
- Parents or guardians must accompany any child under twelve.
- Wrist bands will be provided for each registered participant. These must be visibly worn at all times.
- Cardboard will be provided to build your home for the night
- Entertainment will be provided until 12 midnight, after which all participants are expected to retire to their respective cardboard houses for the remainder of the event.
- We expect all participants to show courtesy and respect to others.
- No alcohol or drugs will be permitted on the premises. Those who break this rule will be removed from the event.
- No radios, video games, etc.
- Bring a pillow and sleeping bag.
- Wear warm clothing.
- Bring a non-perishable food item to be donated to the shelter.
- Free soup, sandwiches, hot chocolate, coffee, tea and water will be provided until 11pm.
